

- 1) The matches should be 2 sets or 3 sets in duration.
- 2) If a 3rd set is played, this can take the form of either a conventional set or a 'Championship Tie-Break' for which the same rules as a normal tie-break apply but first to 11 points (and 2 points clear).
- 3) The decision as to whether or not to play a 3rd set (and if so, what type) should the score reach 1 set all shall be agreed by the players prior to the match.
- 4) Players winning a match when playing somebody above them shall leapfrog up the ladder. The person beaten will drop down one place.
  
- 5) The ladder will be reissued once a month and a list of scores will be issued to keep players informed of progress.
